

HEALTHCARE ARTWORK SPEC SHEET

Calming nature photography for patient-centered interiors.

Fine art photography by Dan Sproul selected for healthcare waiting rooms, patient rooms, consultation spaces, corridors, wellness clinics, and restorative environments.



DESIGN INTENT

Artwork should do more than fill a wall. In healthcare interiors, it can soften the room, provide a visual pause, support wayfinding, and help clinical spaces feel more human.



PATIENT ROOMS

Fog, water, islands, and soft monochrome imagery create a restful focal point without overwhelming the room.



WAITING AREAS

A single large landscape can make arrival spaces feel less institutional and more considered.



CONSULTATION

Forest and tree imagery works well in offices, consult rooms, therapy rooms, and staff-facing spaces.

CUSTOM SIZING

Images can be prepared for statement walls, patient rooms, waiting areas, corridors, and multi-piece programs.

MOCKUP GUIDANCE

Send room photos, wall dimensions, finish palettes, or renderings for practical artwork recommendations.

PROJECT READY

Available as framed paper, canvas, metal, acrylic, or licensed files depending on project needs.

SPECIFICATION GUIDE

Choosing artwork by space, mood, and function.

Waiting Rooms

Large horizontal landscapes, floral mountain scenes, and soft water imagery. Suggested: 36x48 to 48x72.

Patient Rooms

Quiet images with visual depth but low agitation. Suggested: 30x40 to 40x60, framed paper or acrylic.

Corridors

Repeated horizontal pieces, calming color families, or a consistent regional theme. Suggested: 24x36 to 40x60.

Consult / Exam Rooms

Grounding forest, mountain, or monochrome scenes that feel calm and professional. Suggested: 24x36 to 36x48.

RECOMMENDED FORMATS

Framed Fine Art Paper

Approachable, traditional, and easy to coordinate with healthcare interiors.

Acrylic

Clean, luminous, modern; useful in lobbies, waiting areas, and higher-end wellness spaces.

Metal

Durable and crisp for high-traffic corridors and commercial settings.

Canvas

Warmer, softer presence for wellness suites, senior living, and hospitality-style interiors.



SURGERY WAITING

Monochrome calm for higher-stress waiting spaces.



HEALTHCARE CORRIDOR

Blue-green atmosphere for transition and wayfinding.



CLINICAL ROOM

Black and white mountain reflections for exam and consultation rooms.
